Protect the table top from scratches and other damage while assembling.



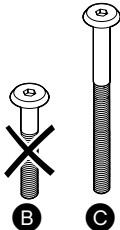
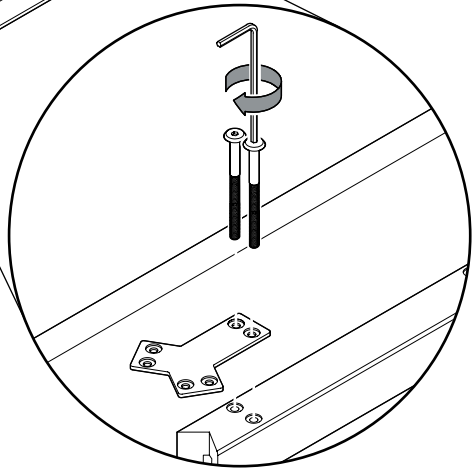

Mount the crossbar **E** to the table top **G**. Place the brackets **F** at both ends, and fasten with screws **C** using the Allen key **D**. Insert all the screws and only tighten them loosely. Do not tighten them completely until step 4.



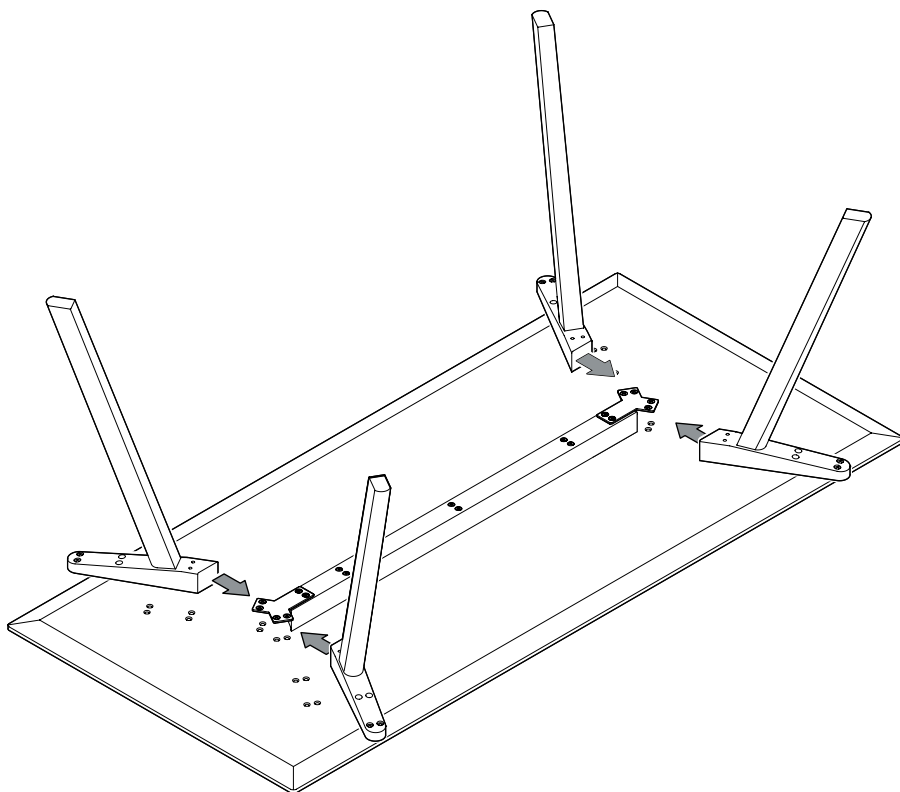

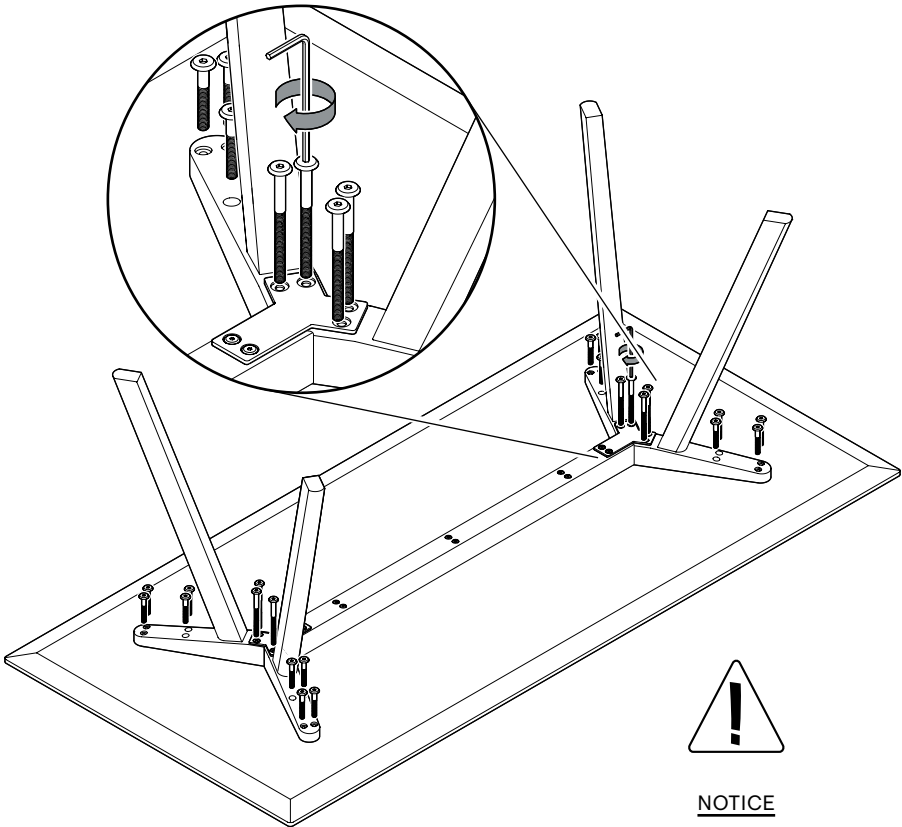

Slide the legs **A** in, underneath the brackets.



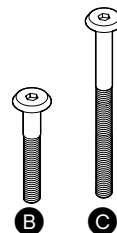
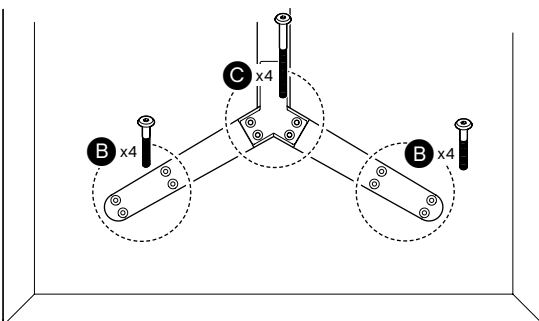

Secure the legs with the screws **B** and **C** using the Allen key **D**. Insert all the screws and only tighten them loosely. Do not tighten them completely until step 4.



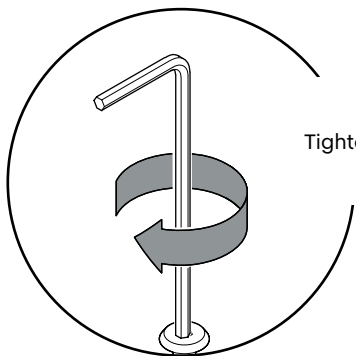

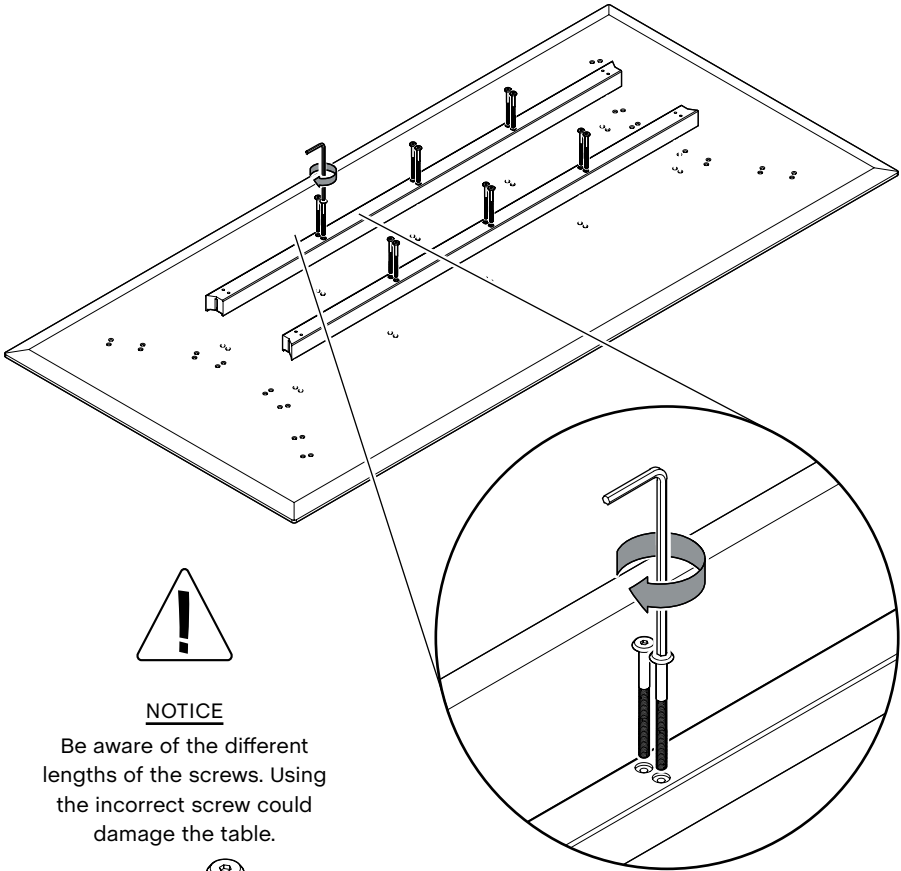
H Table top x1

Protect the table top from scratches and other damage while assembling.



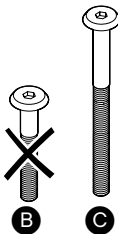

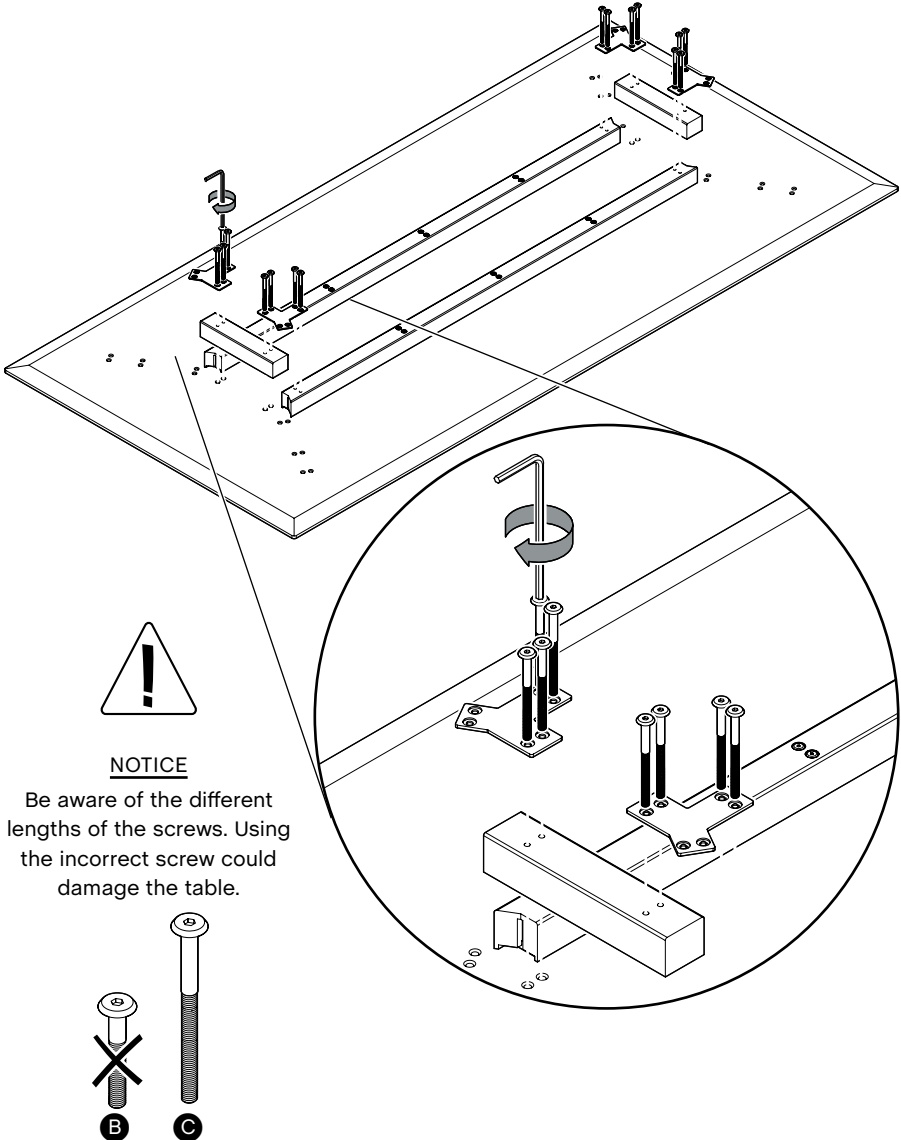

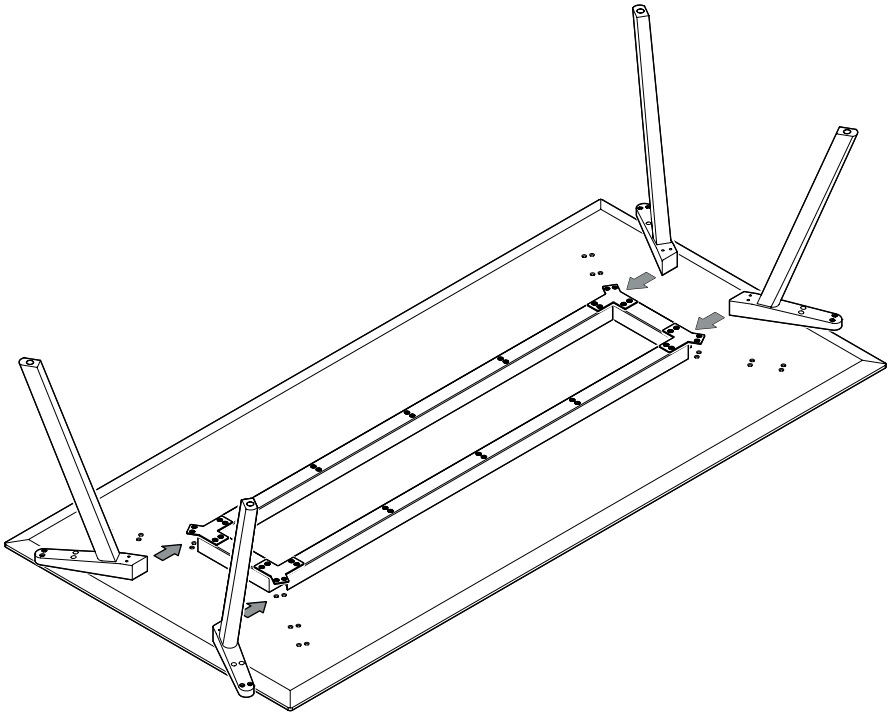

Mount the crossbars **G**. Place the brackets **F** in every corner, and fasten with the screws **C** using the Allen key **D**. Insert all the screws and only tighten them loosely. Do not tighten them completely until step 5.



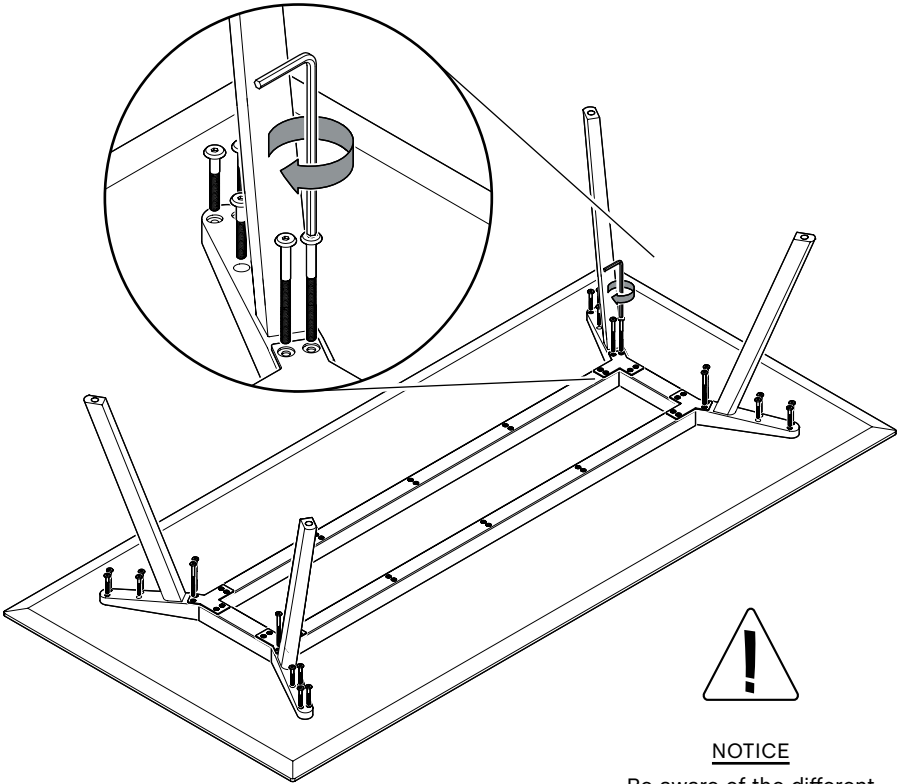

Slide the legs **A** in, underneath the brackets **F** on the table top.



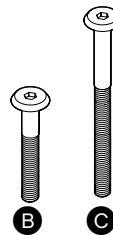
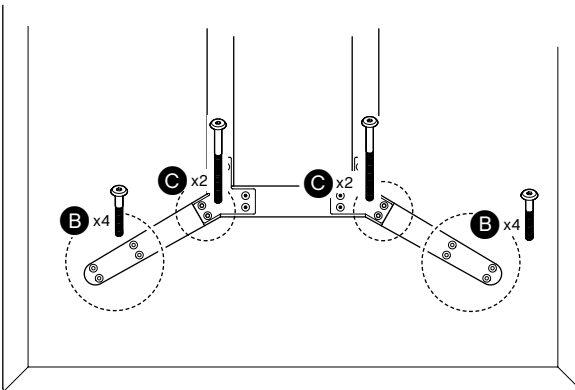
